



# THE Summer's Premier Limousin Event July 4-9, 2010 Hutchinson, Kansas

## GENERAL RULES & ENTRY FORM

### I. ELIGIBILITY: FOR SHOWS

All cattle must be recorded with the North American Limousin Foundation (NALF) to be eligible to show in the All-American Futurity (AALF), Lim-Flex or Fullblood show. Bulls calved after January 1, 2008, and females calved after September 1, 2008, are eligible to show. Cow-calf pairs must have a natural-born calf nursing that is less than 250 days of age show day. Calf at side *may* be shown in individual classes if 180 days or older. An individual animal *may not* be shown in more than one show. All cattle will be checked in by show management—tattoos will be read, hip height measured, and all bulls will be scrotal measured and weighed. EPDs will be made available to the judge(s) in all the shows.

#### A) ALL-AMERICAN FUTURITY

Any animal eligible to show in Level I shows under the standard classification by the North American Limousin Foundation is eligible to show. All cattle must be 75% Limousin or higher. After 5 Club—A member of the After 5 Club who exhibits the AALF supreme grand champion bull will receive \$10,000. A non-member will receive \$5,000. In either case, payment will be made upon furnishing 500 units of semen from the Supreme Grand Champion Bull or one of the exhibitor's herd bulls approved by the AALF executive committee for distribution to the After 5 Club members. All bulls must be entered with this understanding. The grand champion Fullblood, Purebred and Lim-Flex bulls will compete for the supreme title.

#### B) LIM-FLEX SHOW

Cattle that are 25% to 75% Limousin and the balance Angus or Red Angus with no more than 12.5% foreign blood. Cattle must be recorded with NALF as Lim-Flex (purple papers).

#### C) FULLBLOOD SHOW

Fullblood cattle recorded by NALF as fullbloods (NFM or NFF). 25 head must be checked in to show, otherwise they will be shown in the AALF.

### II. HOW TO ENTER:

Entries will be due in the American Cattle Services office on or before **May 15, 2010**. Entry fee of \$50 each shall accompany each entry. \$100 entry fee after May 15 deadline. Cow-calf pairs are considered one entry—\$50 fee, unless the calf is to be shown in an individual class. Entries received after printing of show program must pay a \$300 entry fee. No entries will be accepted after cattle are checked in at show location. Cattle must be entered as recorded with NALF. **No e-mail entries!**

### III. BEDDING FEE:

All cattle in the AALF, Lim-Flex and Fullblood shows that are not entered in the Junior show must pay a \$20 bedding fee—which pays for first-time bedding and tie-out bedding.

### IV. PREMIER BREEDER & PREMIER EXHIBITOR:

Trophies to be awarded to winners of the following group classes: (a) Premier Breeder: Presented to the breeder compiling the most points on six head of cattle bred by, not necessarily owned by said breeder. (b) Premier Exhibitor: The exhibitor whose owned or co-owned cattle accumulate the greatest number of points under the AALF point system.

### V. TRIPLE CROWN AWARD:

This award shall be presented to any bull or female that is named grand champion at the All-American Futurity, American Royal and National Western Stock Shows. The shows must be won in succession, beginning with the All-American Futurity. A trophy will be presented to the owner along with a \$1,000 cash award.

### VI. CLASSIFICATION FOR THE AALF, LIM-FLEX & FULLBLOOD SHOWS:

All cattle will be listed in the program by age, youngest to oldest, by sex. After all cattle are checked in, a committee will break the entries into classes with a minimum age spread. Class winners will compete for division champions, division champions will compete for grand champion. The cow-calf pairs will show first and *will not* compete for grand champion female.

### VII. DIVISION OF PREMIUM MONEY: The premium will be decided upon receipt of entries.

The premium fund consists of the total amount of money paid in entry fees, plus appropriations and contributions from program ad sales and benefit auction funds less administrative costs.

### VIII. NOTE TO JUNIOR EXHIBITORS:

An entry in the National Junior Limousin Show *does not* automatically enter you in any of the other shows.

## HOW TO ENTER:

**A copy of the registration paper** or copy of the application for registry **is the only acceptable form for entering** the AALF, Lim-Flex or Fullblood shows. All cattle must be entered as recorded with NALF.
